### Outstanding invoices:

- Cable Lumber and Home - \$1,675.01
- On December 9, after the rifle sight in days, \$1,070 was deposited. \$720 was collect from site-in day fees and the donation box at the front door. \$350 was from 2023 memberships.
- Please renew your memberships when you can. Once spring is here, DNR Grant #2 work will begin.
- NOTE: the back balance is down because bills like the annual insurance premium get paid.

Income from the Drummond School trap team for the fall season is ~\$2,000.

The remaining mortgage is \$18,720. The annual payment is \$2,340 plus about \$1,000 of interest.

1. DNR Grant #1: Final documents were submitted October 31. (See last month's report.) Awaiting the payment of \$21,438 from the State.
2. DNR Grant #2: We have until October 31, 2024, to complete. 75% reimbursement from the State. Partial payments can be requested throughout the project.
3. The club will renew its line of credit with the Badger Bank as soon as the property appraisals are completed by an appraiser.

## President's Report:

**DNR Grant #2** – (Also see last month's report for additional details.)

1. Fencing: Larry Nelson is providing a layout of the grounds for a bid spec document showing where the fence will be placed. The plan is for two walk through and two drive through locations. Bids will be obtained for chain link and woven wire options.
2. The Berm: The Berm will run south of the club house along Mcnaught Road. Discussion will be held in February with Mark Rasmussen to discuss options and estimated costs.
3. Upgraded trap equipment: The grant has a budget of \$10,000. There was discussion concerning the brands; Pat-Trap and Beomat, and what to use going forward. There are numerous manufacturers. We will stay with what we know and what others in the area are using. This provides for better support. Currently, a Pat-Trap is in house #1. Beomat's are in houses #2 and #3. The current plan is to move the Pat-Trap to house #3 and set it up to throw doubles, put a new Beomat in trap house #1. The older Beomat will be used to add to the sporting clay system. The club also needs a new set of voice activated microphones. A discussion followed concerning corded versus battery operated. Conclusion:
  - a. Purchase on new Beomat Trap
  - b. Purchase one new set of voice activated battery operated microphones.
  - c. Rebuild the Pat-Trap and set it up for throwing doubles.
4. There was a discussion on moving the skeet buildings. There is some deterioration in the construction materials that will need to be addressed. They topic of moving them was tabled until later.

## Old Business:

1. Locating additional shot shells for the upcoming season at a somewhat acceptable price is needed. Possibilities include L&M in Ashland and Recob's in Prairie du Sac. Karl will make calls. But, members, if you know of alternatives, please let us know!
2. Ice Fishing Contest: To Date, the raffle ticket sales have been slow. We expect that to change after the holidays. (Let Kelly Rauch know if you can help finding donations for the bucket raffle.)
3. The Fall 2023, Pig Roast: After some discussion, the decisions made were:
  - a. Leave the raffle ticket costs the same at \$100. But make it clear that a group of up to four can buy a ticket. Make note on the new posters.
  - b. A name/names, a contact email and/or phone number will be required. Addresses are seldom proved so don't ask.

## New Business:

1. A discussion on tax deductible donations – It was noted that a “business” can make a donation that will count as there is no large standard deduction for a business. NOTE: Check with your own tax accountant!
2. A used but still working refrigerator was made available to the club to update the one in the club house. The plan is to move the existing unit to the serving area down below and dispose of the antique that is there now. This will be a spring project.
